
How does a student submit a TII assignment?

This document will explain how a student would submit an assignment that has Turnitin (TII) enabled.

Upload a TII assignment

TurnItIn assignments are integrated into Canvas so submitting an assignment follows the same process. Locate the assignment link in the appropriate Module or under Assignments in your Canvas course. Select the title to open the assignment. Select the Start Assignment button.

Upload your assignment and then review and agree to the TurnItIn statement and then select Submit Assignment.

Upload a file, or choose a file you've already uploaded.

- Files must be less than 40 MB, a minimum of 25 words, and less than 400 pages.
