Example of explanatory text for students: Questions 1-7 measure perceived control for education. Students who perceive that they are "in control" of their success may have a mind-set that helps them to adjust their behaviors to their situation. Students who perceive that external forces have greater control (e.g. luck, others) may not think about changing their behavior to adjust to the situation, and as a result they may have poorer outcomes.

Scoring

The items within each subscale are on a 1-4 scale. To score, sum items within each subscale. The following table shows the range of possible values within each subscale, and cutoffs for low and high scores.

Subscale	Subscale Range	Scoring - Low	Scoring - High
LOC	5 - 20	Less than or equal to 14	Greater than or equal to 15
SRE	7 - 28	Less than or equal to 20	Greater than or equal to 21
CE	8 - 32	Less than or equal to 23	Greater than or equal to 24
TE	5 - 20	Less than or equal to 14	Greater than or equal to 15

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
